



Initial Start of Contract

A site tour with the previous contractor (Enhanced Landscape Management) and George Andrade took place on June 30, 2025, before the start of the contract. Contract started July 1, 2025, for the maintenance services of Ventura County Oak Park.

Irrigation

An Irrigation system initial check was done of the system. From our initial findings a proposal was sent to fix the system on August 1,2025. The proposal to the irrigation system was approved August 4, 2025, and we are 45% completed. Please note that now that repairs are made more repairs that were ignored have come to light. This is due to the full amount of pressure being reinstated to the system and now the system is fixed to the condition it was supposed to be in before Mariposa Landscapes Inc took over. Another proposal will be sent to fix the system fully and have it in 100% working condition.

On August 5, 2025, several Mariposa employees went to an onsite recycled water supervisor training by Triunfo Water & Sanitation District. We had Santos Valenzuela (Account Manager), Jacobo Rosete (Jr. Account Manager) and Irrigation Filed Supervisor Jesus Martinez.

Maintenance


Mariposa made the decision to do overtime to pick up where Enhanced left off. We did not think the quality was up to what Mariposa provides or what the residents want either and are continuing to work on it. We thank the residents and County for letting us get acclimated with the Oak Park Sites as we have needed time to bring all areas up to the same baseline that can later be improved if they so choose to.

The first rotation has been completed, and we are working on trying to do the rotation in less days than a 45-day rotation.

Pine Needles

We know concerns about pines needles have been brought up multiple times. Dates being (7/31/25) and (8/20/25). We have suggested having the service increased and will follow up with what is best to ensure safety for all. As another alternative or even safer tactic we suggest signs to be placed in the high traffic ideas to help educate and protect the residents.

<u>Chemical Program</u> Please see below chemical we would like to apply in Oak Park to start a chemical program. These have been specially selected, and all laws will be followed when applications are made. No chemical has the active ingredient of Glyphosate as that is banned in some cities, counties, or just not preferred by residents. Having this chemical program implemented will help Mariposa with the weekly management and improve the overall maintenance.
