**RE:** November 2025 MAC Law Enforcement Report

This report covers the period of 10/27/2025 (last produced report) and 11/14/2025. During this time period deputies working in the Oak Park Community responded to 48 calls for service. This is 34 less calls for service than during the same time period in 2024. Deputies also made six self-initiated contacts. There were eight reports taken. All eight were crime reports. No incident reports were made during the time period.

NOTE: Incident reports are generated from calls for service where deputies were unable to establish a crime but documented the incident. Those incidents were reviewed by detectives to see if any further follow-up was required.

Summary of Crimes Documented:

## **BURGLARY**

25-140842 – 600 Block of Riverstone Lane

This location is within an apartment complex. The victim was out of town for several days. The victim returned to find the master bedroom and closet were ransacked and several items taken.
