RE: November 2025 MAC Law Enforcement Report

This report covers the period of November 20, 2025 (last report) and January 23, 2026. During this time period deputies working in the Oak Park Community responded to 224 calls for service. This was 90 more calls for service than during the same time period in 2024/2025. Deputies also made ten self-initiated contacts. There were 32 reports taken. 15 of the reports were crime reports and 17 were incident reports.

NOTE: Incident reports are generated from calls for service where deputies were unable to establish a crime but documented the incident. Those incidents were reviewed by detectives to see if any further follow-up was required.

Summary of Crimes Documented:

RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY

25-153028 – 5300 Block of Tan Oak Lan

This location is within an apartment complex. The victim returned home and found the door ajar. Two bags containing cameras, photography equipment and a computer were missing.

25-158802 – 500 Block of Kellwood Court

While the victim was out of town, during early morning hours of 12/11/2025, four subject were captured on video running from the house and getting into a white BMW SUV. The rear door was found shattered and the bedrooms were ransacked. Multiple items were taken.

26-9435 – 1200 Block of Dumaine Ave

The power to the victim's residence was cut by suspect prior to committing this burglary. Victim called her neighbor who saw two male suspects get into a blue Kia Van and flee the area. Suspect gained access to the residence by breaking the back sliding door of the residence.

THEFT

25-159422 – CVS - 632 Lindero Canyon Rd

ORT INCIDENT – Suspect entered the store and selected over \$1500 in cosmetics. The suspect exited the store without paying and left the area in an unknown vehicle.

25-163651 – 4900 Block of Lazio Way

Porch Pirate Incident – Amazon package stolen

25-166344 – CVS – 632 Lindero Canyon Rd

ORT Incident – Suspect accessed secured alcohol display and stole six bottles of alcohol.

26-6247 – Grand Theft – 1200 Block of Briargate Ct

18 pieces of jewelry taken from victim's residence possibly by known suspect.
