**RE:** June 2026 MAC Law Enforcement Report

This report covers the period of May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2026 (date of last report) through June 17<sup>th</sup>, 2026. During this time period deputies working in the Oak Park Community responded to 141 calls for service. This was an increase of 44 more calls for service than in the same time period last year. Deputies also made no self-initiated contacts in the Oak Park area. There were 22 reports taken. 12 of the reports were crime reports and 10 were incident reports.

NOTE: Incident reports are generated from calls for service where deputies were unable to establish a crime but documented the incident. Those incidents were reviewed by detectives to see if any further follow-up was required.

### Summary of Crimes Documented:

#### **RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY**

26-73329 – 6400 Block of Smoke Tree Ave. – Approximately an hour after the victim left the residence, a male subject approached the front door with a Door Dash bag and rang the doorbell. After confirming the residence was empty, the suspects forced entry through a rear door and burglarized the residence.

26-75952 – Pinewood Ave – The gardeners arrived at the residence and found the rear slider had been shattered and the residence ransacked.

NOTES: These two locations were approximately a ¼ mile from each other. Both victims were elderly. These cases are actively being investigated. The suspects and M.O. follow what we typically see in crimes committed by Transnational Organized Crime Crews (previously referred to as South American Theft Groups).

### **THEFT**

26-71522 – Theft from a vehicle – 5800 Block of Freebird Ln

Unknown suspect(s) forced entry into a vehicle by breaking a window and taking a package from the vehicle.

26-73618 – Stolen License Plate– 5800 E Conifer St

26-73627 – Theft from a vehicle – Oakleaf Ave

The side view mirrors were stolen from a Lexus SUV

26-74180 – ORT Theft – CVS – 632 Lindero Canyon Rd

The suspect entered the store and took approximately \$700 worth of cosmetics
